1.	College Infrastructure	Excellent & Very Good – 61.7% Good – 19.15% Average – 8.51% Poor – 10.64%	Most of the students are highly satisfied with the college infrastructure. Canteen contractor was asked to improve the quality of food. Cleanliness committee was instructed to ensure the cleanliness of toilets. Wi-fi was checked and found working properly.
2.	Curriculum and Syllabus	Excellent & Very Good – 65.91% Good – 15.91% Average – 11.36% Poor – 6.82%	The students are satisfied with the curriculum. The courses were completed on time. Teachers were instructed to use ICT tools more frequently.
3.	Faculty Performance	Excellent & Very Good – 70.59% Good – 11.76% Average – 9.80% Poor – 5.88%	The teachers are available to students, regular and punctual. Courses were completed on time. Smart Class rooms are being used by teachers. The teachers were instructed to use more modern teaching aids and PPT.
